Location: east side of Seyed Hamzeh shrine, Seghat-al Islam Avenue

The poets and mystics graveyard of Sirkhab is reported in many historical accounts. The oldest Persian memorial written by Hamdolah Mostowfi, in 740, has mentioned this cemetery.
